

NO MORE JUVENILE FEES OR FINES IN OREGON

Oregon has eliminated all fines and fees in the juvenile delinquency system. No new fees or fines will be assessed on or after September 26, 2021 (existing judgements for fines and fees may continue to be collected and there may be consequences for nonpayment).

All unpaid fees and fines will be canceled on January 1, 2022.

What **cannot** be charged?

- ✗ Oregon Youth Authority child support fees
- ✗ Court-appointed attorney fees
- ✗ Probation supervision or accountability agreement fees
- ✗ Fees for drug testing, mental health testing, blood testing or saliva testing
- ✗ Electronic monitoring fees
- ✗ General court costs, including: filing, transcripts, and expunction fees
- ✗ Collections or late fees
- ✗ Fines for MIP, truancy, misdemeanors, or felonies

What **can** be charged?

- ✓ Restitution to crime survivors
- ✓ Fees and fines in adult court
- ✓ Service provider fees billed to insurance

FAQs

- ❓ **I owe fines and fees for an old case. Do I have to pay?**
Starting January 1, 2022, all unpaid juvenile fees and fines will go away.
- ❓ **I have already paid juvenile fees. Will I get a refund?**
No. Agencies are not required to refund payments.
